There is a maximum of 4 students per class. Classes will last approximately two hours. You must register and pay prior to attending class.

Camanche Hills has a limited number of shotguns for rent. If you are interested in a rental, call early to make a reservation. Shells are available for purchase in the Pro Shop. Students have the option of bringing their own shotgun and shells. Camanche Hill's instructors reserve the right to inspect all shotguns to determine safety, appropriate fit and suitability for sporting clay shooting.

Good walking shoes or boots, visor or hat and a shirt with sleeves are recommended for comfort and protection. A sturdy belt is required to hold your shell pouch. Eye and ear protection are required and may be purchased in the pro shop.

Classes are offered at 10:00 am and 1:00 pm on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays. Cost is \$25 per shooter plus targets. Targets are .40 cents each.
